The Sumburgh Head Foghorn was built in \_\_\_\_\_ to help anyone out at sea lost in fog.

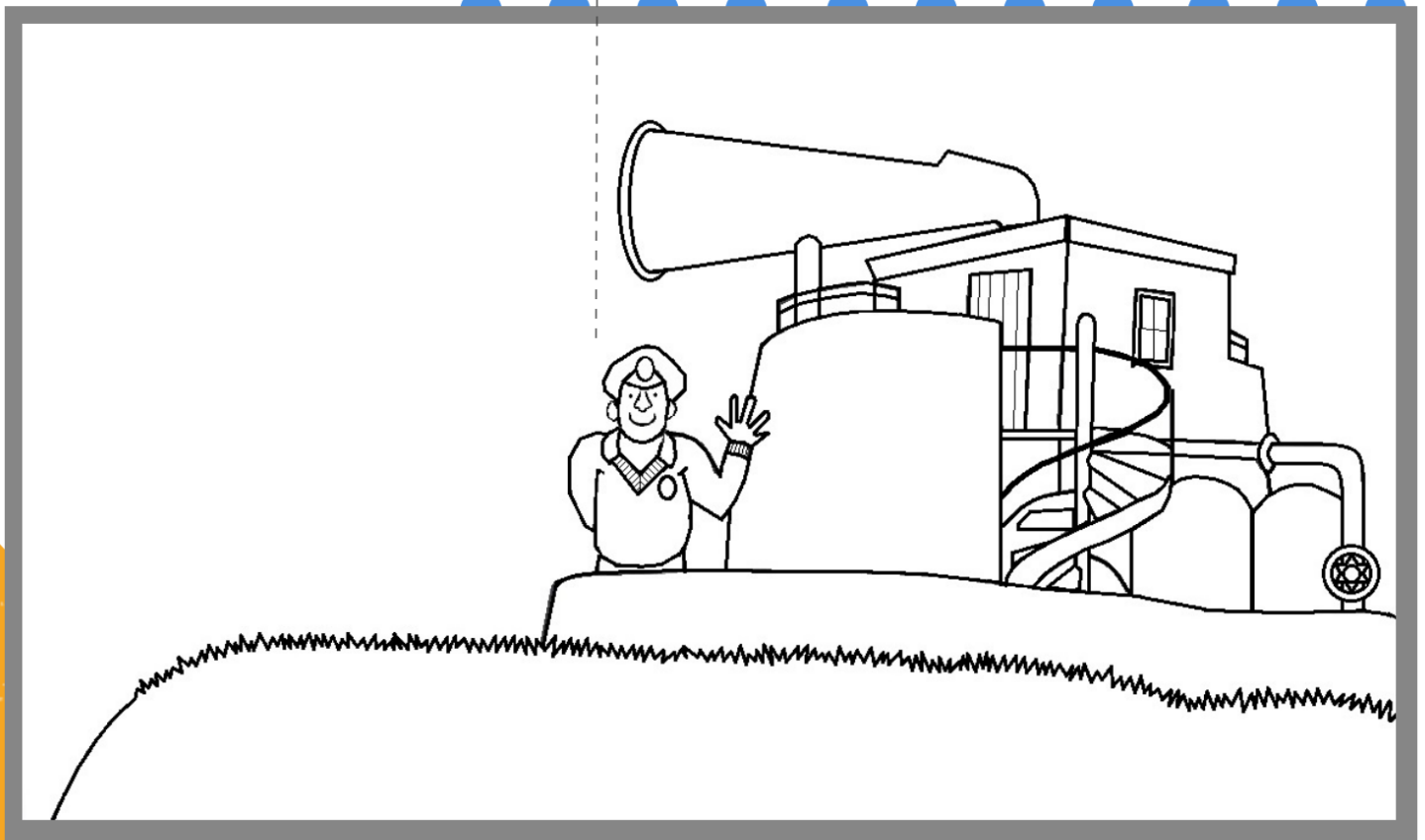
Before the Foghorn a bell was used to warn sailors that they were near the cliffs. This bell now hangs in Dunrossness Kirk \_\_\_\_\_.

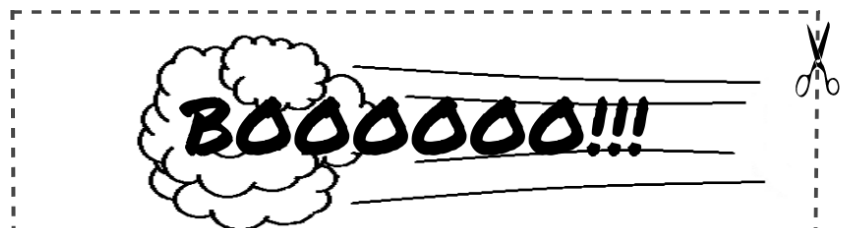
